

As discussed on the telephone earlier today, I apologise for the delay in sending your letter of confirmation of Approval under the above Regulations but due to unforeseen absence from work of the officers who dealt with your premises earlier this year then this has been delayed. As discussed on the telephone, you informed me that nothing has changed since their visits to your premises, the last one being in May 2014 and so I am happy to send your confirmation paperwork in relation to their inspections and assessments of your business at that time.

**Health Marking of Products**

The identification mark allocated to your premises, as indicated on the notification, should appear on commercial documents that accompany the product to its next destination. The mark must indicate:

- The name of the country in which the establishment is located which may be written out in full or shown as the two-letter code UK.
- The approval number of the establishment – **MT 032**
- For an establishment within the Community, the mark must be oval in shape and include the abbreviation EC.
